EMERGENCY TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Carolyn Meadows, attending via zoom called the emergency meeting to order at 4:30 pm and turned the gavel over to Vice-Chairperson Joni Conner, who dispensed with the formalities.

The Clerk stated that the county offices are closed until Monday. The Council was in agreement for the Town Office to be closed until Monday also.

The Clerk stated that the Ochwilla shelter will be open at 8pm tonight and the Police Department and Town Maintenance Department are prepared.
